Enrichment Courses: Students will receive a half credit for the class and it is to be taken with a repeat class or another half credit course.

**Leadership** - This class explores various leadership models, focusing primarily on principles and outcomes of servant leadership.

**Study Skills Class** - A course designed to educate young men on the fundamentals of effective studying and test taking strategies. There will be lessons on critical thinking, active listening, organizational habits, time management and the effective use of technology.

**Test Prep** - A course designed to prepare students for the SAT and ACT tests.

**Personal Finance** - This course explores the fundamentals of personal money management and emphasizes sound decision making and fiscal responsibility as a means to financial health.

**Interactive Virginia History** - A course designed to provide students an introduction to the historical events that helped shape our country. Content will cover early settlement in colonial Virginia, the Revolutionary War, Civil War, the impact of the World Wars and current events. Many lessons will take place in the actual location of the historical event. Field trips will include Appomattox, Monticello and other historic Virginia locations.

**Religion** - This class offering explores the precepts of the Christian faith from a Biblical perspective. Students will also examine the role of the Christian faith in today's world.
