INFORMATION REGARDING DRIVER'S EDUCATION PROGRAM

The Virginia Department of Education has approved an online Driver Education program that can be taken by cadets as a step toward obtaining their driver's license. This program is available to cadets who are at least 15 years of age. If your son is **NOT a Virginia resident**, then you need to check with your local DMV first to see if your home state DMV accepts this course before you register him. There is a \$109 fee associated with this on-line course, which can be paid on the website when you register. You will also need to download the *Permission form for Private School Students* where you will fill out the parent information and then forward the form to Rhonda White @ whiter@fuma.org to complete and send into VADETS. Remember this is an on-line course, and FUMA does not monitor your son's progress with this course. Once your son has completed ALL the coursework, he will then take a FINAL EXAM on a FUMA computer in a designated area and score 85 or better to complete the course.
