

2026 Sway Concussion Testing-Returning Cadets

All Fork Union Military Academy (FUMA) cadets must take a baseline concussion assessment using the Sway software. This assessment will serve as a baseline if a concussion is suspected or sustained while on campus at FUMA. **The cadet must be the person taking the entire test and following instructions on the screen.** The assessment should be taken in a quiet space with no distractions.

Please use the code provided via email communication from SchoolDoc as it directly correlates with the cadet's established profile. Please email collierm@fuma.org if you have not received a code by COB 7/10/2026.

Please note the following additional instructions:

1. Download the "Sway Medical" app for Apple or Android phones; it appears as a blue box with three horizontal lines displayed. 
2. **Phone must be in do not disturb (DND) mode**, please disable the repeat call feature to reduce disruptions.
3. The device should remain in your hands during the full test.
4. The cadet should be the only person to take the entire assessment.
5. Select "enter code" at the bottom of the screen and use cadet's unique code.
6. Follow the instructions exactly as they appear on the screen.
7. When creating a profile, please enter the cadet's full name and double check the birthdate.
8. DO NOT "Skip" ANY PORTION OF THE ASSESSMENT.
9. Run "Hardware Verification" on a flat surface and do not touch the device or surface while calibration is active.
10. Unless you are actively concussed, your symptom score should be close to if not zero.
11. All balance testing should be performed standing with your eyes closed.
12. Complete the remaining sections of the assessment to the best of your abilities.

Please give your best effort; assessments that are skipped, not performed correctly, or do not meet standardized thresholds for the software will need to be retaken prior to the cadet participating in any physical activity on campus.
